**Directions to the Watsonville Civic Plaza:**

**From the North:** Take Highway 1 south to the Riverside Drive exit. Follow Riverside into Watsonville and take a left on Rodriguez Street. The parking structure to the building will be on your right hand side. Park on the sixth level of the parking structure. When facing the building, access the Community Room from the far left door when facing the building.
