At-Large

- Ability to represent the community at-large, otherwise not represented on the Sanctuary Advisory Council; and
- Experience, ability, and availability to conduct outreach within communities adjacent to the Sanctuary consistent with the goals of the Sanctuary and the mission of the Sanctuary Advisory Council.

Commercial Fishing

- Active commercial fisherman familiar with fishing issues within the Sanctuary region;
- Ability to effectively communicate with the broader commercial fishing community in the Sanctuary region;
- An understanding of the links between the commercial fishing community and the Sanctuary; and
- Experience, ability, and availability to conduct outreach within the commercial fishing community consistent with the goals of the Sanctuary and the mission of the Sanctuary Advisory Council.

Recreational Fishing

- Active recreational fisherman familiar with fishing issues within the Sanctuary region;
- Ability to effectively communicate with the broader recreational fishing community in the Sanctuary region;
- An understanding of the links between the recreational fishing community and the Sanctuary; and
- Experience, ability, and availability to conduct outreach within the recreational fishing community consistent with the goals of the Sanctuary and the mission of the Sanctuary Advisory Council.
