## Northern Elephant Seal Presentations - February 16 and February 23

The elephant seal rookery at Piedras Blancas is a dramatic and interesting place to visit year-round. However, the most exciting season is during the winter months when the seals come to shore to birth and mate.

Come join Friends of the Elephant Seal docent, Phil Adams, to learn about the amazing life of the Northern Elephant Seal on land and at sea. After the presentation, you will be able to drive to the elephant seal rookery viewing area only 4.5 miles north of the Center that is manned by knowledgeable docents from FES. Participants will meet at the Coastal Discovery Center in San Simeon (located by the pier that is across Highway One from the entrance to Hearst Castle Visitors Center).
