**MBNMS FEDERAL MPAs INITIATIVE AND DISCUSSION****RAP's Role in MBNMS Federal MPAs Initiative (Mike Eng)**

- Mike gave an update on the process and timeline of the MBNMS Federal MPA Initiative
- The MBNMS is in the beginning stages of conducting an Integrated Ecosystem Assessment (IEA) to assess the status of marine ecosystems and their components
- Next steps include:
  - Convening an MBNMS/NMFS interagency team to develop a proposed framework for collaboratively pursuing an IEA
  - Update to SAC (August 21<sup>st</sup>)
  - Joint proposal by NMFS/MBNMS to PFMC (September 13<sup>th</sup>)
  - Prepare joint cross-cutting proposal to NOAA
  - Recruit additional participants
  - Begin scoping process (early 2010)
- At this time, the MBNMS is developing inter-agency collaborations, and not requesting the RAP's involvement
